



Scholarship for Graduating Seniors

The Junior Football League of Central Illinois (JFLOCI) is proud to announce two (2) financial scholarships for the 2020-2021 school year in the amount of \$1,000 (each) for one (1) cheerleader and one (1) football player. These athletes must have participated in the JFLOCI at one of our JFLOCI Member Areas and also at the high school level. The JFLOCI Executive Board and its 22 Member Areas want to honor and help high school graduates achieve their personal goals after graduation. The due date to apply for this scholarship is 04/12/2021.

Eligibility:

To be eligible for this scholarship, the applicant must:

- Have played football or cheered for a minimum of 2 seasons in the JFLOCI (8Y-14U levels for football OR 5Y-14U levels for cheerleading.)
- Have played football or cheered at the high school level for all 4 years (barring a serious injury of which they were still active with the team.)
- Graduate high school during the application year.
- Be accepted to a trade school, community college, or university.
